Dear Barney,

Just a short note to ask a couple of things:

Could we receive a copy of your (SASO) statement after the Joint Executive meeting. I have been asked to reply to it and circulate it, but have received no copy of it.

Would you or a member of SASO Executive be prepared to speak at National Seminar on the subject of SASO. I would be reluctant to have ~~longer a~~ non-SASO person to do it as I am sure that no-one else is qualified to really cover the subject. I do not see this as 'co-operating with NUSAS' but simply as SASO speaking for itself.

I have heard from overseas that Medical Scholarships was slated very heavily by SASO, I have had no opinion from SASO on the subject directly, and find it difficult to reply to the criticism. As you know Suliman interviewed at UNB this year and if there are complaints about the programme I would like to hear them.

I am at present preparing a paper on the relationship between black and white students as I see it and on a NUSAS point of view on the role of white students and on SASO. If you are interested I will forward a copy. Are you receiving newsletters etc? We do not get your newsletters and I was condering whether this is a matter of policy or just the postal service.

Do you wish to receive/exchange minutes of executive National Councils etc in future?
