

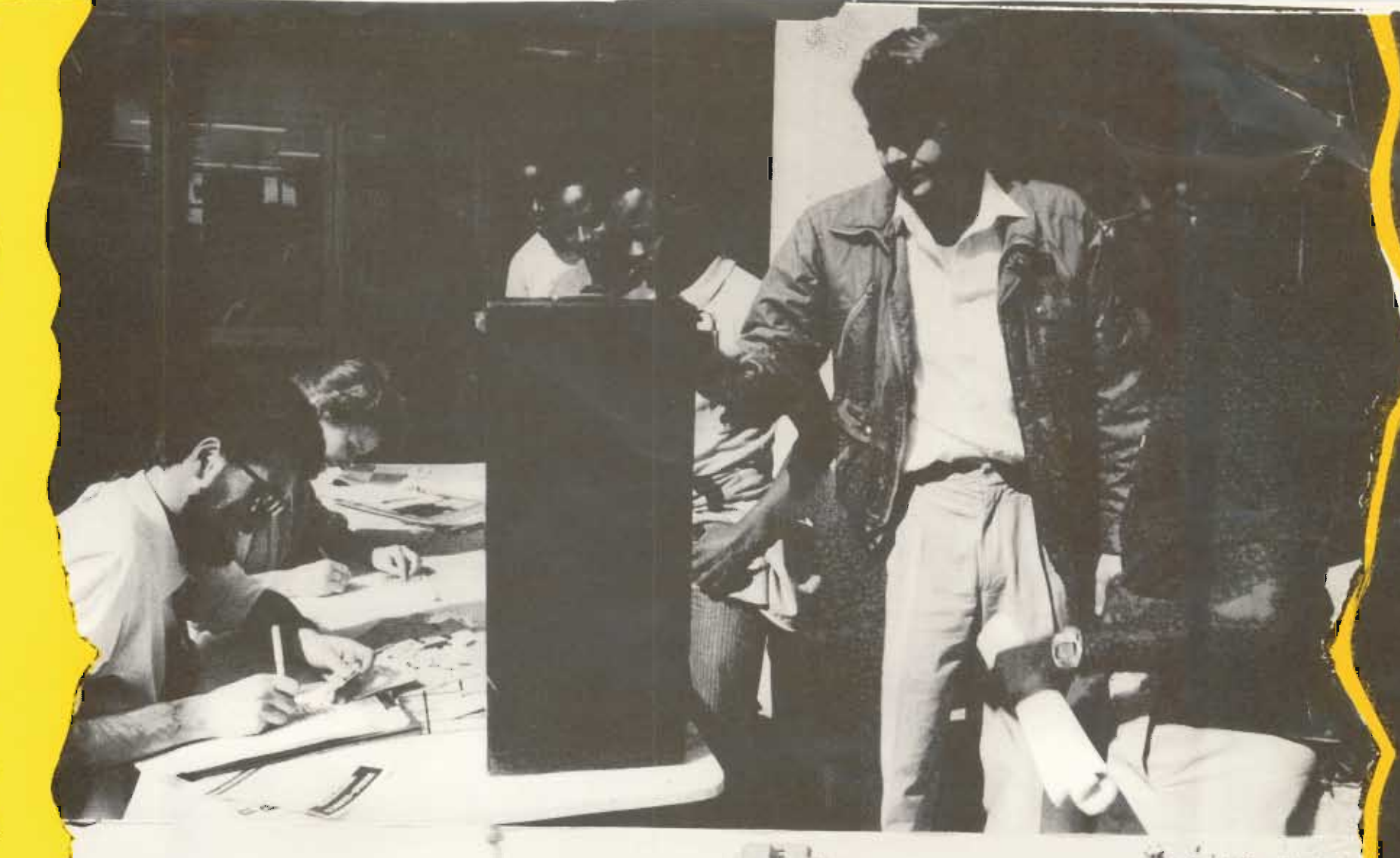


YOU SAID 'YES'

TO 'ONE PERSON, ONE VOTE IN A UNITARY SOUTH AFRICA'

In national united student action:

- Despite police action against students, and use of live ammunition on one occasion, Durban, Maritzburg, Wits, UCT and Rhodes students reaffirm their right to peaceful protest
- Four universities close in protest against police action, and in rejection of the racially exclusive election
- 86% of 13 835 students and staff say yes to 'one person, one vote in a unitary South Africa' in the NUSAS—SANSOCO non-racial poll
- At Stellenbosch, 576 student and 24 academics said 'Yes', while at Tukkies 45 students and 3 academics voted for the principle of one person, one vote in a unitary South Africa
