## b) Other necessary requirements:

- i) all applications must be accompanied by school certificates.
- ii) Age limit: (for both (i) and (ii) student shall no be older than 25-27, and (iii) not older than 23-25. The GDR waives the age-limit for studies/training at vocational level.
- iii) A health certificate must be presented.

\*\*When a definite offer has been made, the NSC needs only to present alist of candidates, providing speciality, level, age, etc.

\*\*\*The NSC should begin negotiating for places with Governments/Ministries of Education in these countries.
